




The 2009 Nationals have now been finalised at a cost of \$1,100 per person and the programme is below. Accommodation for the event will be at the Abbey Beach resort in Busselton WA, <http://www.abbeybeach.com.au> a fantastic venue right on the foreshore and 20 minutes from the Margaret River wine region. Your costs will include accommodation in a studio spa room, all breakfasts and either a lunch or dinner each day as well as a daily one hour sundowner including drinks to catch up on the daily gossip and plan the next day's events.

Competition cost for those entering will be an additional \$140 per entrant for both days' events

Finalised Programme Saturday 31<sup>st</sup> October to Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> November 2009

- Sat 31<sup>st</sup> Registration, sundowner and welcome dinner at Abbey Beach
- Sun 1<sup>st</sup> Show and Shine Day at the Veteran Car Club premises on the Busselton foreshore. This is walking distance from the centre of town and there are many restaurants / coffee places to enjoy a drink or meal. After the sundowner there is an evening meal at a local restaurant.
- Mon 2<sup>nd</sup> Competition at Collie, about 120km away, with non competitors bus excursion arriving at Collie for lunch. There will be sprints in the morning session followed by a hill climb in the afternoon. Finger food at the sundowner and delegates can then arrange their own meal if required. 
- Tues 3<sup>rd</sup> Day trip taking in some outstanding coastal and other sites and arriving at Margaret River for a Melbourne Cup lunch at the Margaret river Resort, followed by visits to several local wineries. This area has some of the best wineries in Australia and produces some exceptional wine. Own arrangements for dinner after the sundowner
- Wed 4<sup>th</sup> Free day with dinner at a local restaurant after the sundowner
- Thurs 5<sup>th</sup> Competition autokhana style close to Busselton with dinner at a local restaurant.
- Fri 6<sup>th</sup> Navigation and observation run with lunch at a local winery or restaurant. Own arrangements for dinner after the sundowner
- Sat 7<sup>th</sup> Brunch at the lovely Clairault Winery, sundowner and presentation dinner at Abbey Beach.
- Sun 8<sup>th</sup> Breakfast at Abbey Beach and then depart for home.
